FINANCIAL LITERACY & AWARENESS

Possessing the skills and knowledge on financial matters to confidently take effective action that best fulfills an individual's personal, family, and global community goals.

For a nominal fee, CAPE offers hybrid Financial Literacy & Awareness Courses to individuals who want to increase their knowledge on how to create and manage budgets, the “Four C’s” of credit and legislation on fair credit practices for consumers and merchants. Our courses explore money values and how we develop those values, how to shop for loans and the right types of credit. We cover the importance of insurance, and how to effectively save for emergencies and long-term retirement goals.

Our classes are taught by a HUD certified housing counselor and are by appointment only. All fees must be paid prior to attending the first class in person or virtually by money order, certified funds made payable to: [Community Action Program of Evansville & Vanderburgh Co., Inc.](#) No personal checks will be accepted.

Each participant must read and agree to the terms of the program guidelines; and sign a “Third-Party Authorization Form” to complete the courses. The eight modules are approximately 45-60 minutes in length with participant activities during and between the classes. Participants must have a working email address and have access to Acrobat Adobe (PDF). Participants will receive a certificate of completion at the end of the final class.

All material, slides and participant guides will be provided by CAPE. The curriculum comes directly from the FDIC “*Money Smart*” program. CAPE is proud to be a part of the FDIC Money Smart Alliance which allows CAPE to receive and pass along Money Smart updates in real time.

All Participant Guides are in English for our instructor-led version of Money Smart PDF-fillable. Participants can follow along on their phones or computers and fill in the questions and activities electronically if they wish. The “*Apply It and Try It*” activities that involve math now also perform the calculations automatically. Participants can focus on the content rather than the math.
